

How to Clean your ZTE Phone

As consumers, we use our phones throughout the day and night. You touch your phone possibly a thousand times daily via emailing, shopping, sharing pictures, etc. Since people wash their hands many times a day to stay clean, it is also be a good practice to clean your phone as well.

Here are some things to keep in mind when cleaning your ZTE phone:

Make sure your phone is powered off and unplugged from your charger. Remove all covers, cases, or connected accessories before beginning.

You can use 70 percent isopropyl alcohol wipes (or a small amount of 70 percent isopropyl alcohol on a cotton ball) to clean your phone. Gently wipe the touchscreen, back cover and other external surfaces. Disinfecting wipes and microfiber cloths are also good options to clean your phone.

Here is what you need to carefully read and AVOID:

1. Never use bleach to clean your device.
2. Do not get any moisture into the charging port, headset jack, speaker, microphone or any other open port on your phone.
3. Do not spray alcohol based cleaning solutions directly onto your phone.
4. Do not use pressurized air which may cause damage to external surfaces and sensitive components.
5. Do not use excessive force to clean the screen or finger print sensors. Very light pressure will be enough to remove any dirt or oils from the device.

Cleaning your phone is simple and it is a good practice to clean your phone once or twice each day. Having a clean phone will make you feel comfortable and confident while using the device.
